I also want to acknowledge the staff who have continued to show up to school each day to ensure that children have a safe and happy learning environment.

The advice we have been given is that schools will remain open but that we should also prepare in case there is a need to close the school. Staff are currently working on this. We ask all families to ensure you have downloaded and logged into the Seesaw app as this is how we will send out learning if the school closes. Any family who hasn't already done this will receive a QR code with instructions today.

In the interests of keeping everyone safe and healthy I remind you to please keep your child at home if they are exhibiting any of the following symptoms:

- Fever (please check this regularly)
- Coughing, sore throat, fatigue
- Shortness of breath, chest pain
