Home Reading

Read your home reader each night and have an adult sign your reading log.

Before reading, discuss what can be seen on the front cover. Do a picture walk of the book before reading it. Encourage your child to 'read the pictures' and create their own story based on the pictures.

Read the book. Discuss the story by comparing the differences between what happened in the text and the story your child predicted/created.

In Literacy, we have been building the students capacity to write an information text. Watch a video or read a book about a natural or man-made landmark in Australia (For example, the great barrier reef, the MCG, the Sydney Harbour Bridge). Record as many facts about the landmark as possible.

Maths

In Maths, we are learning about adding numbers using the count on strategy. Using a dice, create an equation by rolling the two numbers. Write the equation in your home learning book and add the two numbers together using the count on strategy.

Remember to put the larger number first and count on from that number.
For example, $6 + 4 =$

Counting on would sound like: "6...7, 8, 9, 10"

If you do not have a dice, scan the QR code for a virtual dice.
