
Grade Prep Home Learning Term 3 2022 Weeks 8 and 9 Monday 29th of August - DUE: <u>Friday 9th of September</u>

<u>Reading</u>	Writing - Learning Sounds
Please continue the reading activities that are inside your child's reader bag for the fortnight. Reading should take between 5 and 10 minutes each day. Please note that readers will be sent home on Mondays. Please also take the opportunity to read through the library books your child borrows from school. You may like to read this as a family in the afternoons or before bedtime.	This term we are learning the sounds that letters make and exploring words to help us master our sounds. So far this term, we have explored the following letters and their sounds: ch (as in chick) and v (as in vulture). Over this fortnight of home learning, students can show their learning by writing words or drawing pictures of things that begin with the sounds on the template provided:

<u>Inquiry</u>	<u>Maths</u>
In Inquiry, we are learning about how objects move depending on a variety of factors, including their size, shape, and the force applied to it (push - slide and roll, pull - slide and roll, bounce).	In Maths, students are learning about subtraction. This week, we would like you to discuss different ways that you can take numbers away from larger numbers.
This week, we explored how toys can move by pushing or pulling them. Discuss how different objects move-push or pull	Use different objects or a collection of items around the house (e.g., pasta, cutlery etc).
Discuss the following question: Can some objects be pushed AND pulled? Do you agree or disagree? Explore different toys around the house and complete the Push, Pull, Toy worksheet.	Using a collection, discuss how you can take numbers away from larger numbers. Start with a large collection and take away a small amount. Students are to draw and label their findings.

This Term in Inquiry, the Preps are learning about how different objects move. In Reading, students will be practising their alphabet letters and the sounds these letters make.
